# **Instructor, Kinesiology / Head Coach Rattlers Men's Basketball**

Medicine Hat College invites applications for a full-time temporary Kinesiology Instructor/Head Coach of its Rattlers Men's Basketball program. This faculty position is a joint appointment between the Division of Science (2/3) and the Department of Sport & Wellness (1/3). Reporting to both the Dean of Science and the Manager, Sport & Wellness, this position is responsible for instruction in university transfer courses in Kinesiology, physical activity and theory, representing the program and College on various committees, and providing associated administrative duties.

In addition to teaching, the Head Coach oversees the organization, administration and staffing of the Rattlers Men's Basketball Program. The individual will be responsible for all aspects of the collegiate Men's Basketball program from planning, through implementation and evaluation. The individual also assumes a key role in the recruitment of student-athletes, team selection, practice and in-season planning/scheduling, community outreach programs, alumni relations and fund raising activities. The Head Coach is also responsible for the monitoring of student athlete academic success.

In cooperation with the Recreation & Events Supervisor, the Men's Basketball Head Coach will be responsible for the running of the Rattlers basketball summer camps as a revenue generating activity of the program.

Minimum qualifications include a Master's degree in Kinesiology / Physical education or a related field and three or more years of coaching experience at the post secondary level or Provincial club level. An undergraduate degree with a Master's degree in progress may be considered. The Head Coach must have a minimum NCCP Level III certification. Strong communication, organizational, administrative, and management skills are required, as well as significant leadership experience.
